1. Program Features

Period: Monday August 6, 2018 ~ Monday August 20, 2018 (2 weeks, 15 days)

Language: English

Participants: 20 international students from the USA, Canada, Germany or Japan

Contents: Lecture, Excursions, and Trip for understanding culture and industrial development in Korea
Basic Korean Language class (30~35 hours in total, 2 credit hours equivalent)
